## Association

The Raptors softball club play junior and women's softball as part of the Central Districts Softball Association in the North of Adelaide, at Ridley Road, Elizabeth South, a stone's throw from Elizabeth Shopping Centre.

## Training

We train during the season at the Parafield Gardens Soccer and Sports Club located on Bradman Road, Parafield Gardens. Our pre-season training commences in August. Pre-season training is on Sundays. When daylight savings begins we then move to Tuesday evenings.

## Games

Games for women are played on Saturdays from October to April. Games commence at either 12:45, 2:45 or 4:45pm. We ask that you arrive one hour before the game commencement time so that you can park your car, settle in and warm up before the game. We play at Ridley Reserve in Elizabeth South.

## Volunteering

From time to time we will ask that you volunteer your time to help with fundraising events, umpiring and canteen duties. Volunteering is an important part of how our club can grow and thrive. We ask that all people participating in our club dedicate some time to volunteering to help secure our club's growth.



# Fundraising

It is through fundraising that we can keep club fees low, buy equipment and thrive as a club. We have several different fundraising opportunities during the season and we encourage all of our members to participate in these. There are incentives for players and officials who participate in these initiatives and hit targets which include fee discounts and free uniform and merchandise items. We want to help our members, as well as our club, thrive.

# Uniform

Uniforms are navy blue and orange with white and light blue accents. You will need to purchase your playing top and shorts through us before the season. Pants are specially made directly through Emmsee Sportswear or Greatrex. Sizing kits and pricing will be available on registration day. It is expected that you will play in full uniform, otherwise, there are fines issued from CDSA & NAMSA for uniform breaches without valid reasons and permits. Merchandise such as jackets, training t-shirts etc are also available to order through the club. We have a high standard of presentation and ask that you are in the appropriate uniform on games days. Please ensure you are wearing club approved uniform only.

# Team Building

During the season and off-season, we aim to have team-building outings and events. These include dinners, movie nights, bowling etc. We think it is important that we model mateship as part of our team values and these events help to foster that.



# Fees

Your Fees are separated into two groups. One portion is paid directly to Softball SA for your insurance and the other portion is your club fees that you pay to us for your match fees, club and player costs.

You *must* have your Softball SA registration fee finalised before the commencement of the first game. You will receive a link to make your Softball SA payment online before the season. This covers your insurance and registration into Softball SA's database. This year the total SASA fee for a senior player is \$159.99.

When you register you will be asked to pay your full SASA fee.

The other portion of your fees are your club fees. Our club has a number of expenses to cover including match fees for our teams to take the diamond. At the beginning of the season you can choose to pay your club fees in full or on an agreed payment plan schedule.

Your senior Club fees are \$225.

We do have some discounts that apply for coaches, regular umpires and committee members. There are also discount options for families with three or more immediate family members playing. Some conditions apply and we can discuss these with you in more detail.

All players must be financial before the Christmas break in December. Non financial members may be ineligible to participate in finals. Our club treasurer is always here to help you sort out any issues with your fees or making payments.
